Dear Knife Enthusiasts,

In November 2017, the Canadian International Trade Tribunal (CITT) upheld a decision by the Canadian Border Services (CBSA) that classified many folding knives as prohibited weapons. This decision prohibits **the import** of many folding knives into Canada, even though **they are still legal to possess and sell within Canada**. Details about the ruling are below:
